

# Handyworker Program



The Habitat for Humanity of Greater Los Angeles (Habitat LA) Handyworker Program funded by the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department provides up to \$5,000 in **FREE** repairs and property improvements to low-income seniors and disabled individuals to address health, safety and security issues in and around their home.

### Eligibility Requirements\*

- Available for senior citizen (62 and older) or disabled homeowners and renters or households with a disabled member
- Must live in the Los Angeles Harbor Area
  - Harbor Gateway North (Gardena)
  - Harbor Gateway South (Torrance)
  - Harbor City
- Must be a low-income household (see chart)
- Property must be a single family home, condominium, townhome, co-op, mobile home or owner-occupied duplex
- Property must be eligible to qualify for Handyworker services based on property assessment
- Previous participants must be eligible to receive Handyworker services
